Infinite Campus Online Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year Opens Next Week!



APS will launch its online registration/enrollment services on **Monday, May 16**. A single application form will be completed for all children in a single family, eliminating the need to fill out multiple paper applications.

This new enrollment process will be completed in your Infinite Campus Parent Portal on or after May 16. Therefore, we are asking parents of existing APS students to visit their IC Parent Portal before May 16, to be sure your username and password credentials are working properly.
